2010 Yosemite Adventure Tour BMW National Adventure Riding Series Event

Event Description:

The Yosemite Adventure Tour is open to all street-legal motorcycles regardless of make or model. This AMA Sanctioned Adventure Ride is held at the gateway to Yosemite National Park, Buck Meadows California and is a two day, GPS based, self-guided event which includes scenic & historic destinations in and around Yosemite National Park and the Stanislaus National Forest. Using paved and unpaved roads with options of "paved" & "dirt" splits, you'll have approximately 100 miles of fun each day! Dirt routes are approximately 80% dirt. Paved routes are 100% paved. All dirt routes are 2-track gravel and fire roads appropriate for large "Adventure Bikes". This event caters to ALL street legal dual sport & adventure motorcycles. BMW is giving away an F800GS to one lucky AMA Member participating in this year's National Riding Series. AMA member participating in this event are automatically entered in the drawing! Event operated under permit from the Stanislaus National Forest.

Dates:

Event to be held the weekend of Saturday & Sunday May 1st & 2nd, 2010

Registration Fee:

Registration for this event is \$99 per person for AMA member and \$109 for non-AMA members. One day tickets are available, see website for details. Riders and passengers are the same price. Late registration begins April 5th, add \$21.00. After April 26th add \$51.00.

Directions:

From Highway 99 or Interstate 5 take the Highway 120 exit East towards Yosemite. Stay on Highway 120 for about 65 miles till you arrive in the town of Groveland. Buck Meadows is a small community about 11 miles East of Groveland, towards Yosemite.

Amenities:

Lodging is available at the Yosemite Ridge Resort <http://www.yosemiteridge.com/> (800-706-3009) which provides cabins, full RV hookups and local dining. The "Yosemite Westgate Motel" is also in Buck Meadows and the "Lost Claim" campground is only 1 mile away. Additional accommodations are available in Groveland.

Walk-Up Registrations / Staging Location:

Walk-up registration is available Friday at 5pm and resumes at 8am Saturday. Booth & staging location is on the grass next to the general store and fuel pumps in Buck Meadows. There is a limit of 100 riders so get your registration completed early.

GPS Routing:

Bring your GPS!!! A download of routes, waypoints & destination is emailed to you a week before the event. If registering at the event, bring your GPS download cable.

Training Opportunities (NEW!):

Come EARLY! You don't want to miss this! We will be offering two training opportunities on Friday, April 30th:

FREE GPS Class – Friday 6:45pm: "GPS and the Adventure Motorcyclist" author Lawrence Borgens will be teaching how to use a GPS to navigate while motorcycling!

Adventure Bike Class – Rob Rickert - The Dirt Bike Coach - will be giving one of his information packed courses on how to operate a large adventure bike in the dirt with confidence. Beginners and experts alike will benefit from this fun and exciting experienced based training.

Scenic Ride:

THIS IS NOT A RACE!!! This is a fun, EZ-to-follow, on/off-road, leisure, scenic and historic ride through parts of the beautiful Stanislaus National Forest and Yosemite National Park.

Motorcycle Requirements:

- Quiet muffler with a spark arrester is mandatory and only helps our sport. Nothing above 94db.
- Must be street legal with all required lighting, licensing, registration and insurance.
- You will need to be able to go at least 75 miles on a tank of gas.

Other Information:

- Destinations and routes are recommendations. The Yosemite area has SO MUCH to offer that you should not limit your experience.
- GPS downloads include additional waypoints at various locations of historical and scenic interest.
- A small reference map showing destinations, routes & bailouts is handed out during registration.
- Bring rain gear in case of bad weather. This is a rain or shine event.
- Bring a camera! This is a beautiful area!
- Lunch will be provided both days.
- "No-Host" dinner on Saturday night. Afterwards we announce awards, raffle prizes & recognize sponsors.
